

TDAC Family:

As Pastor Keith announced on Sunday, our building will re-open for worship services this Sunday, June 21st. We are looking forward to being able to worship together in person again! We thank you for your understanding and cooperation during this unprecedented time.

For us to be able to meet in person, we are choosing to adhere to Saskatchewan Health Guidelines. We ask that everyone does their part in following the guidelines listed below.

We strongly encourage attendees who are medically vulnerable to delay their return to services and continue to participate in services online on Facebook and YouTube.

Anyone who is sick or has knowingly been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID19, is required to remain at home.

Upon entering the building, hand sanitizer will be available. There will also be hand sanitizing stations located within the building in different areas.

Each person who plans to attend the service is encouraged to register. Preregistration is available in order to facilitate smoother flow on Sunday mornings. You can preregister with the church via phone or email (please include your name and phone number) by Friday at 3:30pm. This information will be kept in the church office and only shared with Public Health to make notifications in the event that someone attending one of our services tests positive for COVID19.

In accordance with Saskatchewan's Re-Open Guidelines and our District Office, we can accommodate 30% of seating capacity or 150 people (whichever is less) in **each** of the following: sanctuary, gymnasium, and fellowship hall. In order to maintain proper distancing, this allows for 90 people in the sanctuary and 75 people in the gymnasium.

All physical contact, such as handshaking or passing objects between individuals, is not permitted. Ushers, greeters or other volunteers will maintain social distancing and avoid physical contact with attendees.

There will not be any children's programming at this time. The children's ministry rooms will be closed until further notice. Children must remain in the service with their family.

Singing is considered a high-risk activity because the virus can be transmitted through saliva or respiratory droplets. Therefore, when singing, participants must wear masks. We ask all attendees to please come prepared by bringing their own mask. In the event that you do not have a mask, the church will provide a disposable one.

The Coffee Shop will remain closed.

The Library will be closed on Sunday mornings. If you wish to borrow a resource from the library, please visit the church during the week, during office hours.

There will be no access to mailboxes on Sunday mornings. To gain access, please visit the church during the week, during office hours.

There will be no water fountains available.

There will be no access to the kitchen.

There will be no chartered Handibus service until further notice.

The debit machine will NOT be available for use. For those who wish to give their offering, please come prepared with cash/cheque or use one of our online giving options. These include: etransfer to tdac@sasktel.net, PushPay, Credit Union Bill Payment Option, or contact the office to set up Pre-Authorized Giving.

Seating in sanctuary will be on a first come, first serve basis. Seating will be arranged so that physical distancing can be observed at all times. Individuals from the same household may be seated together and should remain in place once they are seated. A minimum of two metres must be maintained between household groups. There will be overflow seating in the gym and fellowship hall. The same rules will apply in these areas. There will be no seating in the foyer.

Following the service, attendees will exit the sanctuary/gym/fellowship hall in an organized manner, pew by pew, under the direction given. Attendees will be asked to exit the building immediately following the service. Any visiting must be done outside, maintaining social distancing.

Following each service, worship areas and other areas used will be sanitized.
